

Now, the rush grass has been carefully prepared. But the final step lies in the hands of our craftsmen.

Igusa is an agricultural product. Each strand is different—some are thicker, some thinner, some harder, and some softer. The craftsman's skill lies in removing damaged or uneven parts and preventing the rush from breaking under the tension of the warp threads.

Even when using the same igusa, the character of the tatami omote can change completely depending on the weaver. Its crisp texture, smoothness, and overall finish are all shaped by the craftsmanship of weaving. First, see it. Touch it. Breathe in its aroma. Then, simply lie down and relax...

We believe that tatami should bring you a moment of pure comfort through all five senses.
