

Igusa is not grown from seeds. Instead, seedlings are propagated by dividing established plants, helping to maintain consistent quality.

Every three years, we renew our seedlings through research institutions to prevent deterioration from repeated propagation. At Gozakura Juhey, however, we also carefully select the finest seedlings ourselves and continue this selection year after year.

These exceptional plants pass their qualities from one generation to the next. Through continuous selection and refinement, we strive to develop them into the “thoroughbreds” of igusa varieties.
